Parent/Staff Conference Procedure

Teachers hold three parent conferences per program year to enhance the knowledge and understanding of both staff and parents of the child's education and developmental progress in the program.

Initial Parent/Staff Conference

Teachers and parents share and discuss the process and results of their children's developmental screening. The teachers also asks parents to share information of children's home language, interests, learning styles and temperament. Teachers introduce and familiarize parents to the School Readiness Goals and provide parents with the opportunity to share any questions or concerns they may have.

Second Parent/Staff Transition Conference

Teacher and parents share and discuss information that will prepare them and their children into the next transitional school setting. Parents share their experience with the selected School Readiness Goal that was discussed during the Initial Home Visit. If the child has an IFSP/IEP on file teacher and parents discuss their plans for the new school setting.

Final Parent/Staff Conference

Teachers and parents discuss and share the learning accomplishments and services provided during the school year. Teachers and parents discuss their engagement with the School Readiness Goals. If an IFSP/IEP is on file, teacher and parents discuss parent's engagement with the implementation of their child's goals.
