- 1. Must have participated as a parent or student in the NINOS, Inc. Head Start/Early Head Start Program in Cameron or Willacy Counties for at least one (1) school year.
- 2. Must meet attached NINOS, Inc. Scholarships Guidelines; provide proof of household income with W-2, Tax Return, Check Stub, etc.
- 3. Former or current Head Start/Early Parents applying must be attending a minimum of 2 classes per semester or be attending a college, university, or technical school.
- 4. Former Head Start Student applying must be attending a college, university, or technical school.
- 5. Must be a resident of the NINOS, Inc. service area of Cameron or Willacy County. If the student is attending school out of service area, they must be a current/former Cameron or Willacy County resident.
- 6. Must submit an essay of at least **300** words stating why financial assistance is necessary.

- 8. Can only receive 2 (two) NINOS, Inc. scholarships while enrolled in College.

General Information for Child Development Associates (CDA):

All Applicants:

- 10. Must have been a participant as a parent/former parent or student in the NINOS, Inc. Head Start/Early Head Start Program in Cameron or Willacy Counties for at least one (1) school year.
- 11. Must have a high school diploma, equivalent (GED), or junior or senior in a high school career/technical program in early childhood education.
- 12. Must be a participant in the NINOS, Inc. CDA training to fulfill necessary credential requirements. In addition, the recipient will submit a valid Driver's License, obtain a TB skin test and a criminal/fingerprint clearance.
- 13. Upon completion, the following prerequisites: The CDA applicant will submit to the Council for Professional Recognition the completed application.
 - a. Complete 120 hours of formal early childhood education training with no fewer than ten training hours in each subject area. (Hours must be earned through an agency or organization with expertise in early childhood teacher preparation and must verify your education in the form of an official transcript, certificate, or letter.)
 - b. Within three years, have 480 hours of professional work experience in a group setting with children of ages 0-5 years.
 - c. Within six months, put together a Professional Portfolio and distribute and collect Family Questionnaires.
- 14. Must be able to speak, read and write well enough to perform the responsibilities of a CDA.
- 15. Must meet attached NINOS Inc., Scholarships Income Guidelines; provide proof of household income with W-2, Tax Return, Check Stub, etc. If using check stubs, indicate the number of working hours per week.
- 16. Must submit an essay of at least **300** words stating why financial assistance is necessary.
- 17. Must submit an essay of at least **300** words stating personal goals. (Please include your name on all Essays. Essays must be typed and use a 12-font size)

A distinguished panel of committee members will make the final selection. Incomplete applications will not be valid.
